Bulk sendouts (for information sendouts)

Save time by sending the same information to multiple people at the same time

Bulk sendouts is part of Doctrin's vision of a great communication platform - where time can be spent with the patient instead of repetitive tasks. With this feature, you can create an information sendout and send the same information to multiple people at the same time.

Sendouts with extra help

The basic functionality is the same as for regular sendouts. If you add recipients that are missing any required information, the platform will help you by showing what needs to be added.

Pilot projects & feedback

In parallel with the development of this new feature, a few units have participated in a pilot project to evaluate Bulk sendouts for information sendouts according to their specific needs.

Some of their test scenarios have been;

- sending information about parent groups and e.g. baby activities.
- informing about start of the vaccination season and how to book an appointment.
- invitations to participate in a group treatment in a digital meeting room.
- sending training schedules and similar for a group treatment.

To send to a larger group of recipients

In cases where there is a larger group of recipients, it is possible to import a CSV file instead of adding each recipient individually. [Learn about working with CSV files.](#)

The patient profile focuses on patient safety by providing an overview of a patient - see ongoing and closed cases

- keep track of scheduled sendouts and what has already been sent.
- see which cases where the patient has included photos.
- see a graph of the assessments a patient has filled in, and follow them over time.
